In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, instructions issued in the reference 1<sup>st</sup> were reiterated, to the effect that the Departmental Officers should obtain Photostat copies of the documents and hand over the originals to the Police, so that simultaneous action in regard to criminal proceedings and disciplinary action may be taken to avoid delay, manipulations and loss of evidence. Now it has been noticed by the Government that wherever Government ordered for departmental enquiry, while the case is under investigation by the Anti-Corruption Bureau under prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, certain departments are dropping further action based on the representation given by the Accused Officer.

2. In the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited, the Government directed all the Departments of Secretariat that no order shall be issued dropping further action based on the representation given by the Accused Officer, while the case is under investigation by the Anti-Corruption Bureau under Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and they should await the receipt of the final report of the Anti-Corruption Bureau along with the advice of the Andhra Pradesh Vigilance Commission.

3. All the functional heads of APEPDCL are directed to follow instructions of Government issued in the Circular Memo.6346/ Ser.C/A1/2011-1, General Administration (Services-C) Department, dt.29-06-2011 and Circular memo, vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited, scrupulously (Copies enclosed).

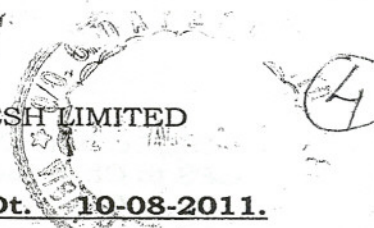

Now, it has been noticed by the Government that wherever Government ordered for departmental enquiry, while the case is under investigation by the Anti-Corruption Bureau under prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, certain departments are dropping further action based on the representation given by the Accused Officer.

Therefore, the Government hereby direct all the Departments of Secretariat that no order shall be issued dropping further action based on the representation given by the Accused Officer, while the case is under investigation by the Anti-Corruption Bureau under Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, and they should await the receipt of the final report of the Anti Corruption Bureau along with the advice of the Andhra Pradesh Vigilance Commission.

3. All the Departments of Secretariat shall follow the above instructions scrupulously and see that the same should be followed by the Disciplinary Authorities under their control.
